When you are ready to transfer, you will need to submit an online application with all requested official documents. In the event you are not in good legal or academic standing at the time of transfer, admission is not guaranteed. Our Admissions team make the final decision on your application.

For full admission to a bachelor's completion program at Northeastern University's College of Professional Studies (CPS), the following admissions criteria must be met prior to enrollment:

- Completion of a Davis College Associate Degree or completion of at least 60 semester or 90 quarter credits toward a degree (grades
 of "C" or higher are required for credits to transfer).
- Evidence of English proficiency: completion of an AA/AS degree, or transcripts reflecting completion of at least 2 years of study (60 credits) at a regionally accredited US Institution, or proof of completion of an accepted English proficiency test with a score meeting minimum requirements.*
- Davis College minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5

Please note that upon successful completion of your Bachelor's Completion degree with a GPA of 3.0 or higher, you may also be admissible to one of the University's graduate programs offered in Boston, or at one of our regional campuses. If you enroll in a second degree at Northeastern you are eligible for the "Double Husky" scholarship, which represents a 25% tuition savings on the second program.
