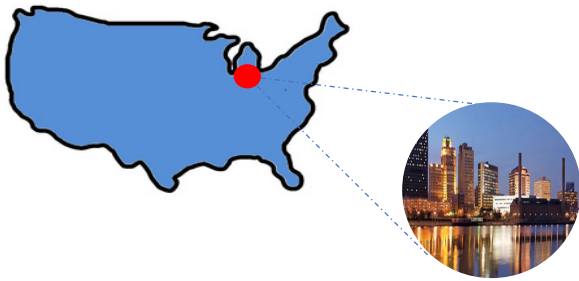
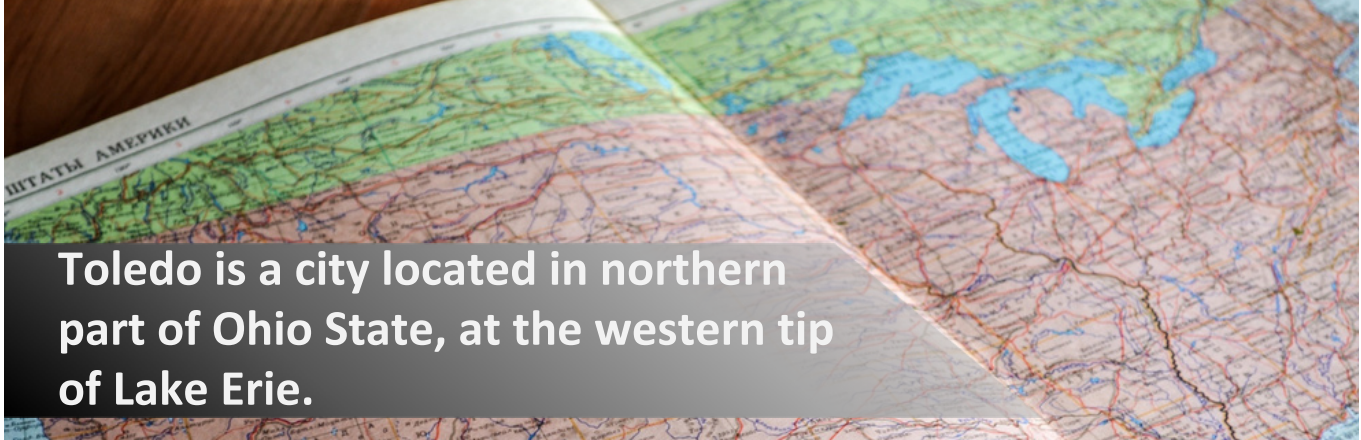

# OPPORTUNITIES AND REQUIREMENTS

## START YOUR JOURNEY

### University Transfer Pathway (UTP)

Our University Transfer Pathway program offers students an opportunity to complete their four-year bachelor's degree. The transfer program provides courses equivalent to the first two years of a university degree. Students can take two years at Davis College, then transfer to a university to complete their four-year degree upon fulfilling admissions requirements.

### High School Completion Accelerator (HSCA)

The High School Completion Accelerator partner with Wesley College Preparatory School provides students with opportunities to complete a high school diploma and college credits transferable towards a bachelor degree. It saves time and money when students enter college before completing high school and graduate from university at least one year earlier than their high school classmates.

### Intensive Language Learning Program (ILP)

ILP is an intensive language learning program that is offered by American Learning Advant-edge (ALAE) at Davis College. It is designed based on solid scientific theories in the field of teaching English as a second/foreign language, where brain-based approach is utilized to maximize the student's learning experiences.

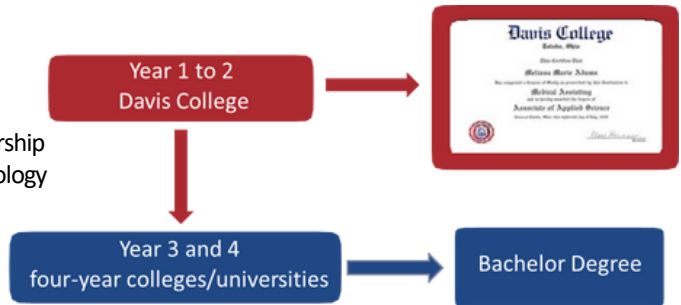

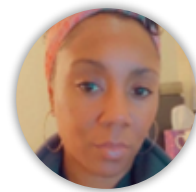

# APPLICATION



## 1. Submit the application

The application form:

- Academic records and transcripts from all secondary/high schools previously attended. English translations must accompany documents not available in English. Current high school students need to provide enrollment certificate indicating the expected graduation time
- **\*Official documents are required to be provided no later than the end of the first year**
- photocopies of English proficiency scores (\*no more than five years old)



## 2. Receive the admissions offer

After we receive your complete application with required documents, we will notify you the admissions decision based on holistic review within two business days.



## 3. Confirm enrollment and pay the deposit

To accept our offer, you will need to complete the online enrollment agreement as directed, provide below documents for I-20 form and pay deposit paying towards your first quarter of tuition fees before the enrollment deadline.

- A copy of your passport identification page
- Bank statement (no more than six months old, covering your first year of tuition and expenses)
- If the bank statement is not in your name, you must send a signed Affidavit of Support form



## 4. Receive the admissions package

An admissions package will be created for you within three business days. This contains an official acceptance letter with your student ID number, I-20 form, F-1 visa process guideline and other relevant information for your arrival.



## 5. Arrive on campus

As soon as you receive your F-1 visa, please email us so that we can plan for your arrival.

- An individual admissions appointment will be made for you to complete the enrollment process.
- An individual academic advising appointment for scheduling classes will be made for you.
- Student Orientation is scheduled the Thursday before classes begin.
